The CPI Group (UK) Ltd is a group of lithographic and digital printers, including pre-press and finishing, whose activities include the production of high quality commercial print, report and accounts, corporate print, paperback and case bound books operating from a number of sites across the South of England.

The Group is committed to the prevention of pollution and to environmental improvement and to this end has created and implemented an environmental management system corresponding to the requirements of ISO 14001.

The Group is also committed to compliance with environmental legislation and relevant industry codes of practise and to the introduction of best practise methods of working within Group companies.

The main environmental impacts of the Group have been identified as those relating to:

1. Use of energy
2. Waste
3. Solvent emissions

Objectives and targets are set within the Group companies to manage and reduce these impacts.

We recognise that for the Group to achieve our overall aims this will involve co-operation at all levels between CPI and its subsidiary operating companies with the support of our suppliers and customers.

To support this, we have a Group environmental management system with specific responsibilities at both group and operating company level.

This policy is reviewed on a regular basis as the Group and industry knowledge and technology evolve.
